1) Between the 28th and 29th of November 2023 in Zaragoza (Spain).



During this Transnational Meeting the consortium discussed about different arguments:

The debate activity for the project will involve 60 young students from different countries, with 10 participants from each partner's country. These 60 students will be divided into two groups, with each group consisting of 30 participants.
